On behalf of Cranleigh Football Club, we are reaching out to you for support as we look to continue our progress both on and off the field.

Cranleigh Football Club is England Accredited and a Surrey FA Member. We are one of the oldest in Surrey. Formed in 1893, the 2025/26 season marks our 132nd anniversary, an achievement matched by only a handful of other clubs in the area.

In recent years, we've seen phenomenal growth. We now cater for boys and girls from ages 5 to 18, adult men and women, and walking football. This year, we'll have close to 50 teams and over 650 registered players, most of whom live in and around Cranleigh and the surrounding villages.

Our senior men's teams have enjoyed notable success, with both sides securing promotions and strong cup performances in recent seasons. The First Team now competes in the Surrey County Premier League at Step 7 of the football pyramid.

The women's team is also going from strength to strength. With growing numbers and increasing local support, the squad continues to develop every season. Their progress on the pitch is clear to see, and the team is fast becoming an exciting part of our club's future.

As a club, our vision is a little different. While we want to build on our success to date, we see progression from our youth teams into a receptive adult structure as a key differentiator.

Our recent accomplishments have largely been built on this model, and we're committed to continuing this approach. By creating a brand of football that promotes youth and is attractive to watch, we're confident that we can sustain this positive trajectory.

We understand you have several options when considering marketing and community outreach opportunities. Kit summary

Cranleigh FC's home colours are blue and white striped shirts, with blue and white short and socks. Our away colours are typically yellow shirts with blue and white socks and shorts.

As of the 2024-25 season, Cranleigh FC primarily uses playing kit and training wear from VX3.

However, as kit cycles typically last more than one year, we still have in circulation kits by Macron. These will be phased out over time.

The senior men's first team uses bespoke kits by Jota, and these are committed for the 2025-26 season due to existing sponsorship. The women's senior team is currently using Macron kits.

Bespoke sponsor packages are available with regards to kit sponsorship, and all senior teams have sponsor availability for away kits also.




Website traffic

During the 2024-25 season, we had nearly 9,000 visitors to the website, amounting to over 27,000 views.








